

Ironing Cover for TV Tray

Supplies Needed:

Silver ironing board fabric	19" x 25"
Insul-Bright® insulated lining	16 1/2" x 22 1/2"
Cotton fabric	17 1/2" x 23 1/2"
3/8" elastic	36"

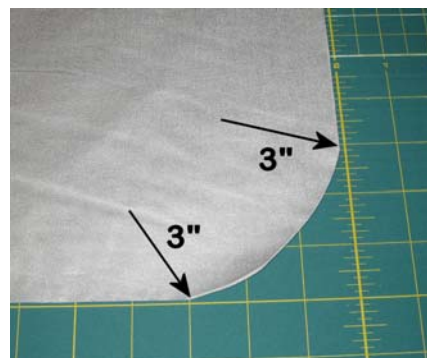
Helpful Tools:

Bodkin for threading elastic through casing.



Beginning 3" from each edge of the corner, arc each corner of the silver ironing board fabric.

Serge or zig zag stitch around all edges of the ironing board fabric being careful to just skim the raw edge of the fabric.



Stitch 5/8" from the edge all the way around the ironing board fabric. This seam provides an easier way to fold the edge around the Insul-Bright® and cotton fabric.

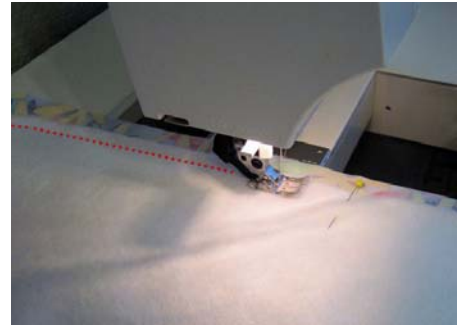


Beginning 2" from each edge of the corner, arc each corner of the Insul-Bright® and cotton fabrics. This arc is less than the one used on the silver ironing board fabric since the fabric is smaller.

Place the cotton fabric right side down. Center the Insul-Bright® over the cotton fabric. Lay the Insul-Bright® with the shiny side up.



Stitch the Insul-Bright® to the cotton fabric. This seam should be stitched ½ inch from the edge of the Insul-Bright®.



Lay the silver ironing board fabric face down on your cutting surface.

Place the stitched Insul-Bright® and cotton fabric over the silver ironing board fabric with the cotton fabric right side up. Center the cotton fabric so there is an even amount of silver ironing board fabric on all edges.



Fold the ironing board fabric over the cotton fabric using the stitched line on the silver fabric as your guide for the fold. The corners will require multiple pins to get a smoother look.

Beginning on one of the long straight sides, stitch close to the edge of the silver fabric, leaving an opening to insert elastic.



Using a bodkin or safety pin, insert elastic through the opening. Pull through the opening and lay the elastic ends on top of each other. Stitch the elastic ends together. Pull it back through the casing. Stitch the casing closed.

This cover fits a standard TV tray.
